

COMPETENCES AND FUNCTIONS

To the portfolio of the Saxon Ministry of the Interior belong all the affairs of the state administration, for which there is no other State Ministry responsible, especially:

- general civil service law (except the salary and the maintenance law), the employee representation law, apprenticeships and further education
- statistics
- organisation of the structure and the development of the administration
- division of the national territory and the land, elections and referendums
- administrative reform
- general administrative law
- conformance test committee (in cooperation with the Saxon Ministry of Justice and the State Chancellery of Saxony)
- local administration including remuneration (if the Saxon Ministry of Finances is not responsible), local consumption and excise tax and the property and business tax (if the communities are responsible for the administration), local e-government;
- citizenship, registration, passport affairs
- public safety and order
- fire and disaster prevention
- armed forces (if the Saxon Ministry of Finances is not responsible), coordination of the civil defence, military and civilian service
- fire service, fire protection
- rescue service
- data protection
- surveying and mapping, geobasis information
- monument protection and preservation including the Department for the Conservation of Historic Buildings and Sites
- aliens law
- protection of the constitution
- archive management
- foundation law, supervision of the foundations
- architecture, housing and settlement including construction inspection, housing allowance, supervision OVER the Chamber of Architecture and Engineering

- land development, regional policy and planning, cross border European territorial cooperation/ INTERREG III B
- unclear property circumstances
- questions of principles and coordination of planning, organisation and application of information and communication technology; e-government at the Saxony State Administration
